A RESOLUTION OF WELLINGTON CITY APPROVING THE ADDITION OF JUNETEENTH TO THE LIST OF PAID UTAH STATE HOLIDAYS


WHEREAS WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL MUST APPROVE THE ADDITION OF THE FEDERAL HOLIDAY JUNETEENTH TO THE LIST OF UTAH STATE PAID HOLIDAYS.

WHEREAS, Wellington City, Utah (the "city") will now approve the addition of Juneteenth – National Freedom Day. The Juneteenth National Freedom Day holiday is on June 19, if that day is on a Monday. If June 19 is on a Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, the Juneteenth National Freedom Day holiday is on the immediately preceding Monday. If June 19 is on a Saturday or Sunday, the Juneteenth National Freedom Day holiday is on the immediately following Monday.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED BY THE LEGISLATIVE BODY OF WELLINGTON CITY, UTAH:

1. The mayor may approve any minor modifications, amendments, or revisions to the Agreement as may in the City's best interests and in harmony with the intent and purpose of the Agreement as substantially.
2. This resolution takes effect upon adoption.
